

INSTALLATION GUIDE:

Student Premium (formerly SEK), Student Standard (formerly SDK), and Student Edition

Three types of Student Products

1. Student Standard (formerly Student Design Kit - SDK)
If you have obtained a SDK-ID from your local reseller then you can go to www.SOLIDWORKS.com/SDK and fill out the form shown below to start the download process. You will receive your serial number via email. Note: Please check your junk mail if you do not see it within an hour of submitting the form.
2. Student Premium (formerly Student Engineering Kit/Student Access – SEK)
If your school is eligible then they should have received this serial number as well as an SEK-ID from your Local reseller. Once you have obtained both of these, you can go to www.SOLIDWORKS.com/SEK and fill out the form shown below to start the download process.
3. Student Edition (SE)
These licenses can be purchased online through a Local Reseller or the SOLIDWORKS Student Store (<https://store.solidworks.com/studentstore/default.php>). If you requested a download instead of the DVDs then you will receive installation instructions via email.

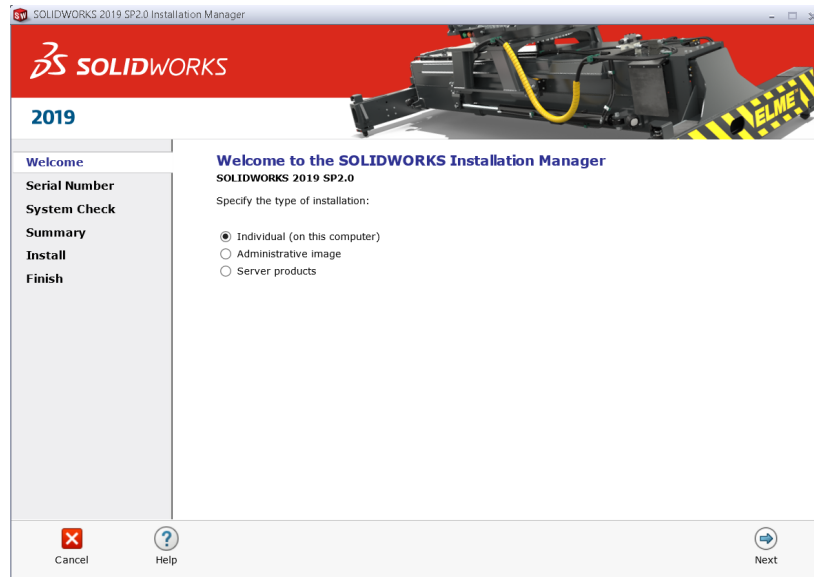
Installation Steps

1. Insert the first DVD into your computer and run the setup.exe file.
If you do not have a DVD or a disk drive, go to www.SOLIDWORKS.com/SEK and request a download of the Installation Manager by completing the form below. You must have a School License ID, SDK-ID or SEK-ID to complete the form.

2. Once the Installation Manager is running, select the option “Individual (on this computer)” and click the “next” arrow.

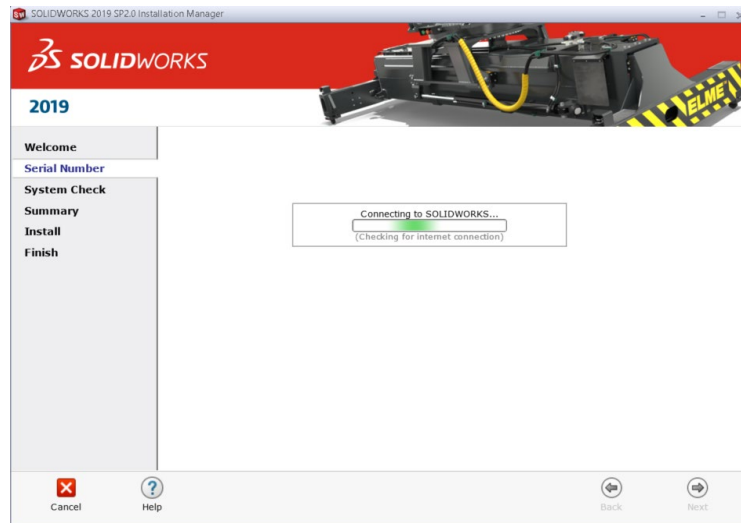


3. Input serial numbers of the products that you want to install.
 - a. SOLIDWORKS Serial Number for Student Premium and Student Editions includes the following products:
 - i. SOLIDWORKS Premium
 - ii. SOLIDWORKS Simulation Premium
 - iii. SOLIDWORKS Flow Simulation
 - iv. SOLIDWORKS Motion
 - v. SOLIDWORKS Plastics Professional
 - vi. SOLIDWORKS Sustainability
 - vii. SOLIDWORKS Electrical Professional
 - viii. SOLIDWORKS Model Based Definition
 - ix. SOLIDWORKS CAM
 - x. SOLIDWORKS Composer
 - xi. SOLIDWORKS Visualize Professional

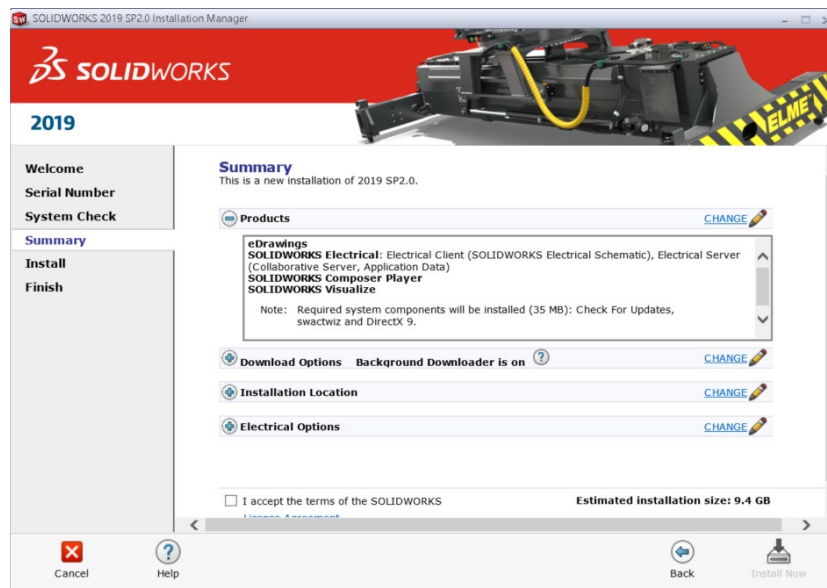
Note: Student Standard include SOLIDWORKS Standard.

4. If you want to install all the products then click next arrow, otherwise click “product selection”.
5. If you clicked “product selection”, this will take you to another screen where you can choose the products you would like to install. You can only select products that your serial number gives you access to.
6. After selecting the products you would like to install click next.
7. The Installation Manager will now check and verify you have the system requirements to run SOLIDWORKS. If something is amiss, you will be notified. This process may take several minutes.

8. Once your system has been checked, you will be taken to a summary screen displaying all of the products you will be installing. Check the box marking that you accept our terms and conditions and click install.



Note: Products shown may vary depending on the version of SOLIDWORKS you are using.

9. If you are installing **without** the DVDs, SOLIDWORKS will first need to download all data and then install. This may take some time.
10. Once the installation is complete, click "finish" and you will be able to use your SOLIDWORKS products.
